Information notice on personal data processing

Recipients of personal data

Data may be transmitted to personal data processors engaged by GPW in connection with services provided to GPW, e.g., advisory, audit, IT services.

To the extent of the clearing of exchange trade, data are transmitted to Krajowy Depozyt Papierów Wartościowych S.A. GPW may transmit personal data to public authorities if required by applicable law. Personal data may also be transmitted in case of suspicion of criminal offence or fraud, in which case GPW may transmit the data to a supervisory authority.

Data retention period

The data retention period depends on the purpose of the processing. GPW will process personal data for as long as required for the purpose of processing in question and in accordance with the applicable retention periods required by the relevant legislation.

Rights of data subjects

Every person has, within the limits of the law, the right to access their personal data, the right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, the right to data portability, and the right to object to the processing of their personal data on the basis of legitimate interests of the controller.

Where personal data are processed on the basis of consent, every person has the right to withdraw consent without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

Every person has the right to lodge a complaint concerning data processing with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

Data sources

Personal data may be sourced directly from data subjects, from an exchange member or exchange member's client, and from a party to an agreement concluded with GPW.

The applicant declares that he/she/it has read the information notice concerning processing of personal data by the Warsaw Stock Exchange (GPW) and undertakes to provide the notice to persons whose data he/she/it discloses to GPW in connection with the procedure for admission to operation on GPW and subsequent operation on GPW.
